

## WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER AN INJECTION

## • General Instructions:

- Avoid activities that put excessive strain on the affected body part for the week following the injection
- Apply ice to body part for 20-30 minutes twice a day on the day of and day following the injection (exception: for PRP and BMAC injections, apply HEAT)
- We recommend you take Ibuprofen (Advil), Naproxen (Aleve) <u>or</u> Acetaminophen (Tylenol) the day of the injection and the following 2-3 days if needed for mild pain or mild swelling at the injection site
- There is a slight risk for a flare-up reaction with introduction of a needle into a joint that is already inflamed or irritated;
  - Symptoms include: increased pain, swelling, soreness, difficulty with weight bearing
  - Apply ice and take Ibuprofen, Naproxen or Acetaminophen to relieve symptoms
  - Symptoms may last up until 1 week after injection

## • Cortisone/Steroid Injections:

- Numbing medication will last 4-8 hours; be sure to ice and take NSAIDs on day of injection
- Cortisone/Steroid will provide pain relief at around 24-28 hours following the injection
- Effects of injection may vary and can last from a couple of weeks to 2-3 months, sometimes longer;
- You may have a repeat cortisone/steroid injection every 3 months as needed
- Visco-Supplementation Injections (i.e. HA, Synvisc One, Gel-One, Visco 3, Orthovisc, Euflexxa):
  - Numbing medication will last 4-8 hours; be sure to ice and take NSAIDs on day of injection
  - Relief from pain and other symptoms may take up to 4 6 weeks following the injection
  - Effects of injection vary and can last from 6 to 12 months
  - Medicare covers (1) injection per knee every 6 months; both knees cannot be injected on the same day
- Bone Marrow Aspirate Concentrate / Platelet-Rich-Plasma Injections:
  - Numbing medication will last 4-8 hours; be sure to apply **<u>HEAT</u>** and take NSAIDs on day of injection
  - Relief from pain and other symptoms may take up to 4 6 weeks following the injection
    - Patients report approx. 50% relief at 6 weeks; 90-100% relief at 3 months following injection
    - Repeat injections every 3-6 months as needed if proven beneficial after initial injection
